Carl Bogdanoff is a Viticulture Biologist at the Pacific Agri-Food Research Centre in Summerland BC. He was born and raised in California where he received his B.Sc. in Biological Science and his M.Sc. in Viticulture from University of California at Davis.

After completing his education he worked as a cellar technician at Rutherford Hill Winery in the Napa Valley, then as a horticulture technician for apple and grape research programs at Cornell University's Experiment Station at Geneva, New York. In 1994 he began his career at the Pacific Agri-Food Research Centre, first at Agassiz where he worked in greenhouse vegetable plant pathology programs, then at Summerland where he was transferred in 2000 to work in the newly established Viticulture program. Currently he heads several research projects and manages the day to day operations for research in the Viticulture program. Additionally, he led the development and construction of the PARC small lot research winery and is now winemaker for the facility.
